D2L · Updates

As online enrollment grows, it's important to be aware of how D2L can help with some of the management duties of instructors. Intelligent agents are a way to help you automate communication with students, or to send yourself a reminder about communication to send. For example, if students aren't accessing your course in the first week of term, you can automate an email either directly to those students or to yourself about their lack of access.

Class Progress Settings is the first tool in the Progress menu. It can be used by Faculty or students as a way to snapshot all activity in a course. The items shown can be chosen by the instructor per course, so if you want to highlight specific areas of student performance / completion, you can adjust the Class Progress Settings.

Brightspace PULSE is an app for Android and iOS mobile devices (not including iPads) that helps students manage notifications for any items on the calendar, discussions, and news items in all their active courses. This app can be extremely beneficial, but it works best when dates are associated with assignments and activities within courses.
